Refusal of permission to develop

The Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Acts and the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, hereby refuses to permit the development referred to in the undermentioned Schedule as shown on the plans submitted.

Your attention is drawn to the Statement of Applicant's Rights set out overleaf.

Date of application: 3rd May, 1966.

Plans submitted: Reg. No. 1958

Your No. P.T.A.P. 3975/100

Development: Alterations and additions to the rear of the residential accommodation at 116, Albert Street, Camden.

Reasons for refusal:

1. The proposal does not comply with the provisions of the Initial Development Plan for the Greater London area in which the premises are in an area allocated at a density of 1.5 persons per acre.
 2. The proposal would result in a substantial loss of daylight to the existing accommodation in the lower floors of Nos. 116 and 118, Albert Street.
- Further Information: Planning permission would be required in respect of any proposal to change the use of an existing residential unit into more than one such unit or to change the use of more than one residential unit into a lesser number of such units.
