I can confirm that in my opinion the minor elevational changes to the front boundary wall, bin store area and front area steps as described in your letter dated 19th February 1993 and shown on Drawing No. 33-190-15, is not materially different from that approved by letter dated the 25th November 1991 (PL9101010) and shown on Drawing 9112L-10, and can therefore be implemented without further need for planning permission.
