Town and Country Planning General Development Orders, 1963 to 1965

Refusal of permission to develop

In accordance with the above-mentioned Orders, the Council hereby gives notice of its decision made on 27.7.68 in pursuance of its powers under the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, as conferred by Section 24(4) of the London Government Act, 1963, to refuse permission for the development referred to in the under-mentioned Schedule as shown on the plans submitted.

Development: The erection at the Bedford College hall of road nos 25/25 Adenson Road, Camden, of a prefabricated bungalow for a warden's residence.

Reasons for refusal: The proposal constitutes undesirable development of backland in that the building is sited on garden land which should be retained as amenity open space for the residents of the hostel.
