Town and Country Planning General Development Orders, 1963 to 1965

Permission for Development. (Conditional)

In accordance with the above-mentioned Orders, the Council hereby gives notice of its decision made on in pursuance of its powers under the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, as conferred by Section 24 (4) of the London Government Act, 1963, to grant permission for the development referred to in the undermentioned Schedule subject to the conditions set out therein and in accordance with the plans submitted save in so far as may otherwise be required by the said conditions.

SCHEDULE

Date of application: 13 August 1968.

Plans submitted No.: 14042 (Your Plan dated 3 July 1968).

Development: The erection and retention for a limited period of a pre-fabricated bungalow for a warden's residence at the Bedford College Hall of Residence, 25-33 Adanson Road, Camden.

Conditions: The limited period for the retention of the building shall be from the date hereof until 29 September 1978, on or before the expiration of which period the building shall be removed and the land reinstated to the satisfaction of the local planning authority.

Reason for the imposition of condition:

The type of building proposed would not be acceptable on a permanent basis in this location as it would be out of character with surrounding development.
