With reference to your letter dated 9 December 1959, concerning the above-mentioned premises, I have to inform you that the Council has decided to approve the detailed plans, sections, and elevations of a building, part two storeys, and part five storeys, comprising shops and supermarket on the lower ground and ground floors, five self-contained flats on the first floor and five self-contained maisonettes on the second and third floors with ancillary garages at the rear, on the site of Nos. 115-121 Finchley Road, Hampstead, as shown on plans Regd. Nos. 20371 and 27015 (with modification to the rear elevation as described in your letter dated 10 March 1960) (your drawings Nos. 13 and 15 and 14 revised) submitted in accordance with condition (1) of the planning permission conveyed by letter dated 11 September 1959.

I have to inform you of the necessity of submitting full details of the facing materials to be used in the building for the Council's consideration and approval before any work is commenced on the site.
