LOCAL HOUSING OPERATIONS
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947

The Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Act and the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, hereby permits the development referred to in the schedule below subject to the conditions set out therein and in accordance with the plans submitted.

This permission shall not be regarded as dispensing with the necessity for due compliance with any local Acts, regulations, building by-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the City, and particularly the London Building Acts, 1930-39, and the by-laws in force thereunder, and the provisions of the said Acts, regulations, by-laws and provisions shall be deemed to be a consent by the Council thereunder.

The permission does not modify or affect any personal or restrictive covenants applying to the land or the rights of any person entitled to the benefits thereof.
