

The erection of a basement, ground and four storey building, containing Development: retail. workshop and residential uses.

Reason for refusal: 1. The proposed development by reason of its external appearance would adversely affect the character and appearance of the Conservation Area within which it is located.

2. The proposed development by reason of its scale and bulk would be an over-development of the site, and is to the detriment of adjoining residential properties (to the east) which would experience a reduction in daylight and sunlight.

3. The proposed development by reason of the mix of residential accommodation is contrary to the Council's policies as expressed in the Written Statement to the District Plan to provide family sized accommodation in schemes of rehabilitation or redevelopment.

4. The proposed development involves the loss of existing residential accommodation of a type which the Council considers should be retained in this area.
