External alterations to Grade II Listed Building involving replacement of 13 single glazed sash windows with double glazed units using 12mm sealed replica window frames and retention of window boxes.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed replacement windows, by reason of the loss of existing historic windows and inappropriate detailing of the replacement, would not preserve the special architectural and historic interest of the Grade II* listed building. This is contrary to the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, with particular regard to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and



conserving our heritage), and the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies, with particular regard to policy DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage).
