The Council has considered your application and decided to approve details.

Informative(s):

1 The proposed materials samples (burnt cedar timber cladding, natural and gloss finish) are considered to work well with the design of the approved outbuilding, and their colour, texture, finished appearance and longevity considered to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of this part of the Belsize Park conservation area.

The site's planning history and relevant appeal decisions were taken into account



when coming to this decision.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the conservation area, under s.72 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies CS5 and CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP24, DP25 and DP26 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with policies 7.4, 7.6 and 7.8 of the London Plan 2011; and paragraphs 14, 17, 56-66 and 126-141 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

2 You are advised that no further conditions relating to planning permission ref. 2014/0743/P granted on 24/03/2014 require details to be submitted.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
