- 1.1 Refer to the proposal outline for a full description of the Proposed Development.
- 1.2 The likely general construction impacts across The Site as relevant to LVIA are:
  - increased construction activity and vehicles compared to the maintenance operations and police patrols;
  - temporary solid hoardings; and
  - temporary localised closure or diversions of path networks.
- 1.3 Table 6.4.1 below summarises the likely construction impacts at each area of the Site.

- 1.4 The following impacts relevant to the LVIA during the operational phase are:
  - localised reduction in vegetation adjacent a number of ponds within the Highgate and Hampstead Chains;
  - localised changes to landform associated with the new spillways at a number of ponds within the Highgate and Hampstead Chains;
  - new sheet pile walls 1m high at Men's Bathing and 1.25m and Highgate No.1 Pond;
  - new fencing, buildings and structures at a number of the ponds within the Highgate and Hampstead Chains;
  - localised changes to landform relating to the dam raising, including the 2.5m raising on the southern edge of Model Boating and extending the dam within the pond;
  - localised changes to landform due to habitat creation, including the new island and channel to the west of Model Boating; and
  - a new dam at Catchpit.
