consent for the following reason(s):


Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The two Norway maples are considered to significantly contribute to the character of the area. The trees also form part of a green corridor along the Regent's Canal which is considered to be important for the biodiversity of the area. The application does not explain why the trees should be felled. The application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the trees provide and to preserve the character of the area.
