Variation of condition 3 (approved drawings) of planning permission granted on 06/11/2013 (ref: 2013/3231/P for the redevelopment to provide 16 residential units and 545 sqm of ground floor and basement retail space (2 x Class A1 units.), namely the complete demolition of the front façade of Nos. 39 and 45 Gray's Inn Road.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The Council refuses the Minor Material Amendment application (2014/1118/P) at 39-45 Gray's Inn Road, London, WC1X 8PR by reason that the proposed works



cannot reasonably be classified as "minor" given their scale and impact on the appearance of the buildings and the Bloomsbury Conservation Area contrary to policies CS14 (promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage), DP24 (securing high quality design) and DP25 (conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Core Strategy and Local Development Framework Development Policies .

## Informative(s):

- Please be informed for the avoidance of doubt that the proposed replacement façades fails to provide a sufficient quality of architectural design to adequately replicate the original façades. This would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area contrary to policies CS14 (promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage), DP24 (securing high quality design) and DP25 (conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Core Strategy and Local Development Framework Development Policies.
- Please be informed for the avoidance of doubt that the proposed demolition of the façades fails to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area contrary to policies CS14 (promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage), DP24 (securing high quality design) and DP25 (conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Core Strategy and Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
