The proposed installation of 5 x glazed doors, replacing 2 x existing French door openings to rear roof mansard pitch, by virtue of their detailed design and materials is harmful to the special interest of the listed building and would be contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policy DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
