We would like to remove a cherry blossom tree that is the only tree on a lawn that we wish to dig up and replant to have as a continuous rectangular lawn of just grass. It is old and does not blossom anymore and was recently damaged by a branch falling from a much larger tree in the garden. This is an open space where our three young children constantly play and it obstructs this space for them as well as often they are injured running into it. We are redesigning the whole garden and the lawn will be central to this as a play area with no other trees or shrubs on it. We will be planting more trees at the end of the garden off of the lawn as part of the redesign.
