- 3) Please see the attached PDF '151\_C5\_ISSUED\_Planning\_GP\_proposed 120614'. The proposed outbuilding has been set back from the existing tree to protect its existing root build up. In addition we have proposed shallow raft foundations which spread the load over the entire floor area and hence minimise the depth of excavation required. It is also proposed that where necessary, openings in the foundations will be provided as required to prevent disturbance to the tree roots. The raised earth at the rear of the outbuilding will also be maintained, protecting the existing tree at its base.
