The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed roof extension, by reason of its design, height, location and visual prominence within a terrace of properties with an unimpaired roofline, would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the host building, the overall terrace and the general streetscene, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 (Securing high quality design) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
