| T107                  | Plane ( <i>Platanus x hispanica</i> )   | 20.0                    | 750                                       | 17                               | Mature      | Fair           | <b>03.04.08:</b> Previously reduced to 7m, but a reasonably structured crown has grown out. Occasional deadwood of up to 75mm diameter. Main stem has slight lean to north. Basal swelling could be as a result of internal decay - though not indicated by sounding hammer. <b>23.04.08:</b> Internal Decay Detection undertaken: stem sound. <b>13.03.09:</b> No work required. <b>28.04.10:</b> Soil disturbance around base. <b>28.04.11:</b> Crown reduced during 2010, no work required. <b>03.04.12:</b> No work required. <b>30.04.13:</b> No work required. <b>01.04.14:</b> Dead branch at 4m, growing to south, towards T60. | <b>01.04.14:</b> Remove dead branch at 4m, growing to south, towards T60.                                 | 15 - 30   | B                              |

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| T108                  | Lime cultivar                     | 22.0                    | 750                                       | 15                               | Mature       | Fair           | <b>03.04.08:</b> Grafted variety - with graft at 750mm above ground. Below graft point, diameter is approx. 550mm & above graft point it is approx. 750mm. Majority of weight is to west, over children's playground. Decay entering main stem at 1.8m to east. Extensive stress on graft point, which sometimes can fail. <b>23.04.08:</b> Internal Decay Detection undertaken - no decay found. <b>13.03.09:</b> 25% crown reduction undertaken during 2008. Stress on graft point reduced, but still all remaining weight over playground. Carry out further crown reduction in 2-3 years when tree had re-established vigour. <b>28.04.10:</b> Soil disturbance around base. Consider crown reduction during 2011. <b>28.04.11:</b> No work required, consider crown reduction during 2012. <b>03.04.12:</b> Dead branch (150mm diameter) over playground. Specify crown reduction during 2013. <b>30.04.13:</b> Dead branch removed during 2012. <b>01.04.14:</b> Crown reduced/thinned during 2013. | <b>01.04.14:</b> Lift crown to southwest to provide 6m clearance, by removing two branches, circa 150mm diameter back to main stem, together with two secondary branches (circa 100mm), to allow sunlight to penetrate under canopy. Clear remains of neighbour's tree, which has failed and broken across fence. | 10 - 20   | C                              |
