It is unclear what, if anything, is proposed to be planted in their place and, as they stand, the lime trees are 16 meters away from the back facade of the house and for much of the year, provide a wide leafy screen (about 15 meters wide) affording us with privacy from the windows of our neighbours that would otherwise have a direct line of sight into our living space. In keeping with the conservation area, the trees provide a natural backdrop which would be replaced by one of bricks and mortar if the trees are felled and the replanting was not of a similar stature. In the current application there is no specific proposal for replanting. We understand that this application should include such a proposal, detailing the quantity, species, position and size of the replacement trees. Alternatively, the proposal should provide reasons for not wanting to replant. As neither of the above is clear, and given the size and importance of the four lime trees, we feel obliged to object to this application.
