I am the owner of Gangmoor, which abuts Applicant. I own the land between the 2 properties that is constructed as a lightwell to bring light into 4 rooms in Gangmoor and 2 rooms in the Cottage. The west and north walls of my lightwell are faced with shiny white brickwork to bring as much light as possible. The DAYLIGHT STUDY supplied in the Application is wrong on 4 important points: 1-Ground floor kitchen. This room has very large windows and enjoys good reflected light from the white brick walls. Artificial light is not used for much of the day. It is a ground floor room, not a basement room. 2-There is a basement utility room below this kitchen that has light through its glass door- this has been ignored in Application. 3-Ground floor hall has a window in the lightwell. This brings good light into Gangmoor entrance hall. This has been omitted in Application. 4-Second floor Gangmoor room with window in west side of lightwell. This window enjoys good sky views and has been ignored in the Application.</p> <p>The Application would destroy the enjoyment of all these 4 rooms in my house by an unacceptable reduction of natural light entering the existing lightwell.</p> <p>On a separate issue, it is not clear from the drawings supplied whether my bedroom windows facing east on my 1st and 2nd floors (at the north end of Gangmoor) will have their views reduced by the proposed extension of Whitestone House northwards on ground, 1st, and 2nd floors. Please clarify. If so, it would be another objection issue.</p> <p>Please notify me of committee date.</p>

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
