					We are very keen to see this long-term empty property brought back into productive use. The building is situated in a busy and visible location close to Camden High Street, thus invariably receiving attention. It not only represents a waste of resources, but has caused problems for the local community. It has been squatted three times, costing the owners (a Church) considerable funds and efforts to evict. When I visited in March 2012 there were unsightly metal grills on the door and window, piles of beer cans and rubbish in the garden whilst a young neighbouring family complained of noise from the property.	
					A homeless charity is currently occupying the property as a means of protection, but the owner will be applying for a Empty Property Grant from Camden Council to help with building costs and to provide accommodation for Camden's homeless clients.
