Rear Garden

Cork Screw Willow - Approximately 9m. This tree has shown strong regeneration since the remedial pruning carried out some years ago. Reduce crown by approximately 30%, thin crown density by approximately 20%. Reason - to manage the tree at a reasonable size for its location. 2 x Sugar Maple - Approximately 9m. Located on boundary with 68 Frognal, NW3 6XD. Reduce crown by approximately 30% back to previous reduction points ensuring a suitable amount of secondary furnishing growth is retained for crown continuity.
