1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, under Section 171 A (1) (a) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. 3. THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without Planning Permission:

Erection of single storey outbuilding located in the rear garden

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE:

- a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last 4 years
- b) The single storey outbuilding located in the rear garden, by reason of its scale and location, would be overly dominant and appear as an incongruous form of development which would neither preserve nor enhance the character or appearance of the surrounding area, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 (Securing high quality design) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

The Council do not consider that planning permission should be given because planning conditions could not overcome these problems.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Remove the single storey outbuilding located in the rear garden along with all related debris.
