## Town and Country Planning Acts 1990 (as amended) NOTIFICATION OF AN APPEAL

The Council has been notified of an appeal against an enforcement notice which has been made to the Planning Inspectorate.

The appeal concerns a property at:

Duke of Hamilton Public House 23-25 New End London NW3 1ND

and the breach of planning control alleged in the enforcement notice is:

The unauthorised installation of raised timber decking in the beer garden of the public house (Class A4)

Grounds	of Appeal

The appellant/s have appealed on one or a number of the following grounds; (as marked)

- a) That planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the notice.
- b) That the breach of control alleged in the enforcement notice has not occurred as a matter of fact
- c) That there has not been a breach of planning control.
- d) That, at the time the enforcement notice was issued, it was too late to take enforcement action against the matters stated in the notice.



e) Copies of the enforcement notice were not served on everyone who has an interest in the land.	(	)

The appeal will be decided by means of an <u>informal hearing</u> held by an Inspector appointed by the Planning Inspectorate. The hearing date is currently being arranged and you will be informed of the date, time and venue of the hearing when it has been confirmed.
