## Dear Mr Tulloch.

Further to my letter of February 9<sup>th</sup>, previous letters to you and your site visit, I am writing to you again to express my concern about the proposed building works

I note that revised plans have been submitted for these works but I am still very concerned that there is no change in the proposal to extend the present line of the building, so as to significantly reduce the amount of light in my house. As you know, at present the large window on my first floor and the glazed door on the ground floor brings light into the heart of the house and my concern is that, if this building work goes ahead as proposed, the stainwell will become dark and this will make my whole house sombre. I know the revised plans contain a proposal to widen the distance between my property and the new building by 38cms and whilst I welcome this change, it does not significantly address my concern about the amount of light in my house.

As you know, my other concern is the proposal to build a roof terrace on the second floor.
