Firstly, many thanks to Cllr Risso-Gill for the below.

Tania, please can you confirm that the below will be logged as an objection to the latest/3rd application within 4 months.

I'm sure that we would "all" also be very interested to hear your views about the latest application, considering your comments to the applicant in relation to the last application when you made it clear that no such further development at the property would be agreeable.

Equally, I would welcome you to visit the site to see the true extent of the developments that have been completed at the property. I would be happy to show you this from my property next door.

Secondly, As Cllr Risso-Gill also points out, it is now weeks since we contacted the Department about how and why the January application was approved, and have heard nothing.

When we last spoke Tania, you said that you would contact Alex directly again and ask him to contact me – I have not heard anything.

Equally, our various emails have not received a reply either. When we spoke, you stated that you were aware of the issues raised, e.g., why Alex had stated only 2 objections had been raise when we know a least 4/ had been, why such development had been allowed within a Conservation Area, how drinking hours up to 11pm had been allowed, etc. and that it was best to speak with Alex. Again, I have heard nothing. (Emails attached to jog memories).

(When I have also tried to contact Alex on the phone number provided in the attached email, which also outlines the issues that need to be addressed, the line is dead.)

Again, I would welcome you to visit the site to see the true extent of the developments that have been completed at the property. I would strongly urge you to visit me as this again would help to address the issues that have been raised, (Cllr Risso-Gill has already done this and hence her request for clarifications as to how the January application was approved.)

I hope to hear from you both as to the 2 issues above and that you take me up on my offer to view the site in person.
