As a local resident I have always been very impressed by the efforts the owners have made in improving the local environment and their involvement with the local community, I therefore support this application.

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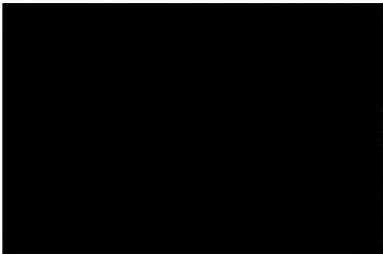

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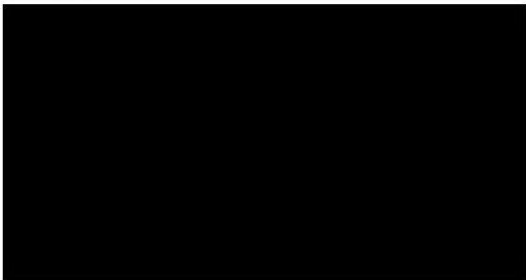
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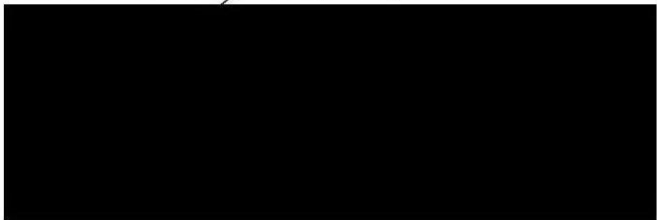
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Your comments

- 1) A large block of flats in Winchester Row / Adelaide Row.

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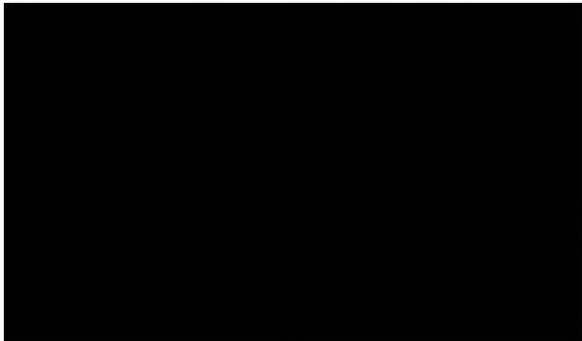
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
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
