or even fourth appeal.

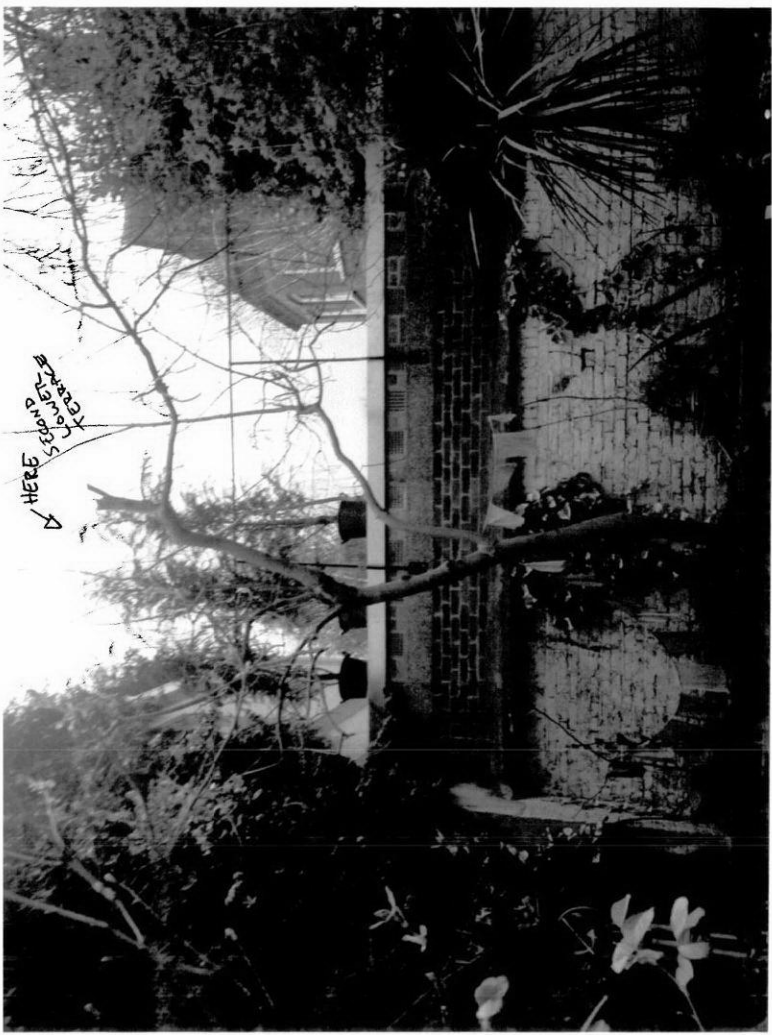
We explained our reasons
