I would like to object to the above proposal on the grounds of damage to the substructure of neighbouring houses as well as to the environment during any building work that will take place. This part of Hampstead is already pock-marked with basement extensions with resulting cracks to neighbouring buildings and I know for a fact that South Hill Park has suffered subsidence over the last fifteen years in the wake of previous work, which, in at least one case, has lead to temporary evacuation and re-housing. The houses are already substantial and I can see no justification for putting the neighbourhood at risk in such a way.
