Please find enclosed a petition regarding the ongoing nuisance that is being caused by the new VQ Restaurant.

Whilst this is a particular part of the problem, this must also be seen as part of the ongoing problems regarding the over intensification of the St Glles Hotel/YMCA site as a whole.

As you can see our residents feel very strongly regarding this.

Residents of 114 homes, taxpayers of Camden, have signed this petition

As the petition shows they....

OPPOSE the planning application to open the windows of the restaurant to the street. Ask Camden officers to take immediate measures to SHUT DOWN the extractor from the kitchens of the VQ Restaurant

To DECLARE it a statutory nuisance.

The original planning/licensing for this restaurant was done without any prior consultation with local residents. No resident objected, as no resident knew anything of it.

Certainly to expect them to keep watch on your website is ridiculous, especially when they had not been warned that this was your way forward with dealing with the tax payers of Camden and their local environs.

Now, again, as with other operations connected to the St Giles Hotel we are to be bombarded with the any opportunity to disrupt the quietude of the area, we are living in a conservation area, and whilst the VQ is not, it's position should obviously be considered when licensing and granting permissions. The edge of such an area must be somewhat grey otherwise the area is in fact lessened...to allow development of such intensity on the very edge of the conservation area and so close to so many residential properties is hugely unhelpful and unneighbourly

Whilst I must say that whilst some Camden officers, Hannah Parker and Maya Rhodes, have been stirred to deal with this extractor problem, we have heard nothing for weeks. There was a rather abortive night time sound check...I feel that VQ had prior knowledge of this, but of course if they were not busy at 3am that day there would be no smell and less noise.

However, we are only in the first few weeks of opening. What happens when the place takes off and we are in the midst of summer with windows wanting to be open and the hotel full of guests wanting to party? Let alone when the night time bus queues on Tottenham Court Road discover it.

I am sorry but this situation is simply not acceptable. We are yet again forced onto the back foot by circumstance out of our control and are left chasing this. This should not be the case.

Why are we the local residents always being forced to respond to matters that should not have been allowed in the first place, be made to prove their case when we are are not those that are doing wrong and without the correct permissions? We believe that our council should be protecting our interests not shrugging shoulders and just accepting whats done is done....your residents are complaining and we need something concrete done on our behalf by Camden and its officers.

I shall also be sending this petition in to object to the planning application 2013/6357/P

Please confirm receipt of this and importantly what action is to be taken on theses matters and when.

## PETITION

St Giles Hotel/VQ24HOUR, Great Russell Street, London WC1

We, the undersigned, petition the London Borough of Camden to take immediate action regarding the above address. This petition has three questions and the undersigned have signed their support for each issue in turn.

## The issues are:

- 1. We object to the planning application 2013/6357/P. Opening up of the shop front will allow noise and odours to spill out onto the street and surrounding residential area. The immediate area includes a mansion block that has 110 homes. Allowing this application will risk the quality of life of the immediate residential area. This application should be denied.
- 2. We urge Camden to use all their powers to shut down the recently up rated extraction system which exits the building over Adeline Place. The up rated system is discharging odours fumes and noise over the public right of way and directly into the homes of the mansion block opposite. We believe this extraction is a public health problem and has materially affected the air quality in the immediate area. The noise, when turned on high power is also totally unacceptable. We believe the machinery was recently up rated without planning and is therefore operating illegally.
- 3. We urge Camden to enforce immediate action over this extraction and have it declared as a statutory nuisance.
