I want to raise three matters: 1) Damage to mature trees: We have 16 mature Lombardy Poplars, already showing signs of distress from works carried out in advance of this application. These include the addition of a pierced steel fence, yew hedge and the raising of the path to protect our land from flash flooding from yet other changes carried out on Witanhurst land. 2) Loss of amenity-privacy. When this fence is added to the existing yew, pierced steel and chain link fences, there will be four barriers each with its different style and with the security path looking straight into our home. It is vital that the new fence is higher than 1.80m. If is put at ground level, then our bathroom and a bedroom will still be open to view for anyone walking along the path. I estimate that if the fence starts at path level then it would need to be over 2.0m. Our rooms became visible from the path since Witanhurst workers destroyed a 2.0 m plus Clematis hedge on our side of the chain link fence. 3) Loss of amenity -health. This new fence will make it impossible to clear dead, rotting vermin (foxes, squirrels, birds etc) along the side of our garden with potential health risks.
