2014/4525/P	Jessica Feather	119 King Henry's Road	30/08/2014 19:13:50	OBJEMAIL	As the owner of a flat in the neighbouring building, 119 King Henry's Road, I am very concerned that the size of the proposed extension and its use as a family dining area will bring about a material increase in both the level of noise and the length of time over which that noise will occur. It would help if the projection were to be reduced from the proposed 4 metres and if the glass enclosures were both double glazed and fixed, that is incapable of being opened. The other consequence of the proposal is to increase the likelihood of cooking smells, particularly if the glass enclosures were to be capable of being opened or if there were to be an extractor fan blowing cooking smells out of the kitchen from whence prevailing winds would take them in various directions. This is an increase in air pollution and a detraction from our right to quiet, undisturbed enjoyment.
