The CGCA would like to remind the Council that Neal's Yard is a residential area. The existing operations in the Yard already cause harm to residential amenity in the surrounding buildings. This includes from noise nuisance and food smells. Adding more morning or late evening operations cannot only add to this harm. Allowing a closing time of 23:00 means noise will actually continue until 23:30, as staff must clean after customers leave. Similarly, allowing an opening time of 07:00 means that noise will begin before that, as staff must set up before opening. The existing hours are appropriate for these operations.</p>
