

Dear Sir / Madam,

Application for Tree Works

We write in connection with the very large plane tree ("Plane Tree") situated on the border line between our house and no. 259, and immediately behind our kitchen extension.

Over the course of the last year, our insurers, through their Subsidence Engineers, GHG, have been monitoring significant movement in our kitchen extension and have now concluded that the cause of that movement is shrinkage of the clay substrata, significantly aggravated by the Plane Tree. The Plane Tree has been reduced during the monitoring period, and indeed on a regular basis prior to it, but this reduction has unfortunately not had the desired impact.

GHG have now concluded that the most appropriate remedy in the circumstances would be the removal of the Plane Tree, and we are therefore writing to you in order to request your consent to the same.
