[REDACTED] and I want to strongly object to the above planning application for a wall and gates to be erected . My reasons are as follows :-

1. The **whole street** has only walls at low level and there are no gates anywhere . Visually therefore the proposed wall and gates will not blend and will destroy the natural existing garden front line .
2. A gate will interfere with pedestrian and road traffic flow . The occupiers , when entering their premises will be blocking the walkway and the road waiting for gates to open . This is dangerous .
3. The oak tree on the corner of no.3 and no.5 will suffer damage and possible destruction because the gate post foundations will damage its roots . This tree is very old and blends very well with the tree and plant life throughout the rest of the road.
4. Incidentally I have been told by our gardener that the tree in the driveway , very old , is also being abused – intentionally or otherwise - and is in danger of dying .
