I write to offer some comments on the planning proposal for the building in Erskine Mews currently occupied by triyoga.

I understand that the owner wants to develop the site residentially.

This would take away a very successful business from Primrose Hill and would also harm- quite severely- the local businesses. Whenever I go to triyoga, frequently, I also shop at the local greengrocer, deli, gift shop, news agent and kitchen shop. And the dress shops- more infrequently.

If the council did a test using the local money supply model (new economics foundation www.neweconomics.org) you would find that the local economy of triyoga depends very heavily on footfall. Which is precisely what triyoga provides.

Turning this lively and popular community resource into flats would be a very unfortunate development.
