1. Design.

The existing window is a white coloured timber sash with clear glazing.

The new window is going to be a timber casement, white coloured and clear and double glazing.

The 3rd December 2013 was submitted a planning application for this property to replace the rest of the windows on the three elevations. (Ref: 2013/7769/P).

The new products will not detract attention away from the original building and will be sympathetic to the character of the property.

The new proposal will only serve to enhance the property both visually and economically, blending naturally with the surroundings.

The proposed window is however, of a much higher quality than the existing install and far more aesthetically pleasing than the current design. The new timber window is much more energy efficient than the older design and will significantly decrease energy loss and subsequently reduce energy bills.

The new products are built on a new technology with included energy saving quality.

In terms of environmental conservation, the proposed new window will only have a positive impact on the environment as the reduction in energy bills will only serve for a more environmentally friendly installation.
