Future maintenance

Following on site analysis in the presence of Network Rail engineers, Network Rail will now accept the position of the proposed building to be within 5 metres of Overhead Line Equipment (OHLE). The developer will now liaise with Network Rail, enter into a Basic Asset Protection Agreement which will ensure the construction of the development will not harm the safe operation of the railway during and after construction.
