As a professional working in space planning and people movement in the environment I'm very concerned about the proposed conversion of Leeder House in 6 Erskine Road; and want to hereby express my opposition to the planning permission.

Firstly, Leeder House and the other units are suitable for continued business use and should be protected as such as indicated under policy DP13.

Secondly, the site is within the conservation area and the change of use, the proposed physical alterations are out of keeping with the character and appearance of the Conservation Area.

And tirdly, a comprehensive approach should be taken to the development of all land/buildings at 6Erskine Road, including triyoga so that the impact can be fully understood and assessed, eg. employment lost aside from what I believe will be a huge negative impact on the High Street and its daily trade.

Please do take these concerns seriously.
