

I got to know about the plans you have regarding the premises of trivoga with much worry.

Triyoga is part of the community of Primrose Hill and has been such for the last 13 years; it is one of the institutions which has created the atmosphere and sense of community for which people like spending time (and money!) in the area. People come to Primrose Hill because it gives a sense of peace and beauty, including its shops, yoga places and restaurants.

The site is within the Primrose Hill Conservation Area and the change of use and the proposed physical alterations are out of keeping with the character and appearance of the Conservation Area. Leeder House and the other units are still suitable for continued business use and should continue to be protected as such as indicated by policy DP13.

Please, adopt a comprehensive approach to the development of all land and buildings at 6 Erskine Road, including triyoga, so that the impacts can be fully understood and assessed (e.g. employment lost aside from what I believe will be the huge negative impact on the High Street and its daily trade). And also not only from a strictly business/money point of view, but also from the point of view of the wellbeing of the community, including the people that go to soak up the atmosphere.

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
