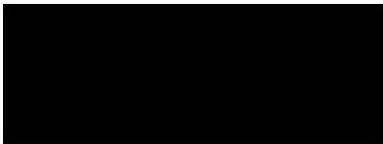

We are very concerned about the plan to convert 1 Raglan Street into a block of flats with a roof terrace (application 2013/6025/P) on the first floor. This external roof terrace, for use by residents, would directly overlook our home and into our first floor bedroom. This would greatly disturb our privacy and, as an outdoor communal space, risk causing loud noise, disturbance, and alcohol drinking in both Raglan Street and Anglers Lane, especially late at night. This is a quiet and peaceful area with homes and we want it to stay that way. For this reason we object to the detail of the plan. However we have no objection to the change to residential use if there was no large outdoor amenity space facing the streets.
