I refer to the above planning application. I understand that this tree has a TPO on it. It appears that the only reason that the applicant wants to pollard reduce this tree is to allow him to erect a large extractor flue up the rear face of the building (see the tree application submitted). The extractor does not have planning permission and in fact planning permission which was once on LB of Camden's web site has now been removed (No. 2013/4690/P). I have objected to this work previously and the extractor (see attached) which will affect neighbours and will be a general eyesore in the area.

Trees are an essential part of Hampstead which is especially relevant to the centre of Hampstead Village. Tress should be preserved not butchered at the will of an applicant. I trust that you will fully take this into account.
