I refer to your letter of 22 July concerning the application for an extension to the groung floor flat in this building. Unfortunately your letter only reached me on Friday 29 August, by which time, as I understand it, the deadline for objections had passed.

This is most unsatisfactory. I am the owner and occupant of the flat immediately above the one in question and I am not happy with the proposed extension. The external wall of this building is jointly owned by all four flat owners/freeholders and none of us is entitled unilaterally to alter it.

Moreover, building work in the area proposed, right underneath our bedroom, will inevitably create a lot of dust and noise. With an old building of this kind the dust will inevitably penetrate into our flat. My wife suffers from serious respiratory problems and is at present recovering from cancer. We have already had to put up with very considerable inconvenience caused by a conversion on the garden floor level of this building last year, as a result of which our own flat was rendered virtually uninhabitable for several months. We do not want to go through the same experience again.

We therefore hope that you will be able to reconsider your decision on this matter.
