You'll have seen Tom's letter; can I ask that when you reply to him to let him know your planning committee's decision you copy me in on your e-mail? This is a rather unusual case in that the Diocesan Advisory Committee's position will depend on the outcome of the planning application. Usually we would not proceed in this way, but our hand was forced in this instance by the parish's decision to submit it before the Committee had completed its deliberations (it was in favour of the scheme as a whole but some members voiced reservations concerning aspects of the detailing of the street front). If you grant planning consent then a Certificate of Recommendation will issue and the parish will proceed to apply for a faculty from the Chancellor of the Diocese. Before a Certificate can issue we'll need evidence that the views of external consultees have been sought. We'll use Tom's letter as evidence that the Victorian Society has been consulted, but English Heritage commented on the application as well and, if so, would you be able to forward me its letter? Do let me know.
