Proposal:

Erection of single-storey rear extension at basement level (following demolition of existing conservatory), replacement of door on rear elevation at lower ground floor level and internal alterations in connection with change of use of basement and ground floor from 2 x 2-bedroom flats to a 1x 3-bedroom maisonette (Class C3).

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed internal staircase between ground and lower ground floor level, by virtue of its impact on the existing plan form and loss of historic fabric, is considered to be harmful to the special historic interest of this grade II listed building, contrary to



policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Core Strategy and policy DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
