Details of privacy screens (condition 4), acoustic report (condition 8), sound insulation (condition 9) and extractor unit (condition 10) of planning permission granted 5/12/12 (ref: 2012/5288/P), for change of use of first to third floor from restaurant (Class A3) to 2 self-contained flats (Class C3) and associated installation of 2 dormer windows, creation of roof terrace and alterations to doors and windows.
