As a constant heath walker and swimmer, I want to object in the strongest terms to this application. It would be disastrous for the environment and beauty of the Lane, which remains one of the most beautiful tracks on the heath. The application will destroy this entirely.

The impact of heavy construction lorries in Millfield Lane would affect pedestrians, cyclists, runners, putting us all at risk.

Other traffic to and from the site using Millfield Lane would also cause a risk.

Large vehicles turning at the entrance to the Water House opposite the pond entrance would be dangerous as well as noisy.

"Improvements" to the lane to make it suitable for heavy traffic is not wanted. Its current natural state is what makes it such a joy.

Possible damage to the plant life either side of the lane would be caused by traffic.

There could be an impact on water quality of the construction work.

Noise and dust would be intolerable.

The noise and dust from nearby work at Fitzroy Farm has shown clearly what the consequences of this application would be.

This application must not be allowed to go ahead.
