I am a Camden resident and frequently walk along Gloucester Crescent and enjoy its splendid old Victorian houses. I also am a frequent visitor to and admirer of the quite exceptional garden at 70 Gloucester Crescent.

I object to this proposal on 2 grounds:

1. The external appearance; the front elevation of the proposed development is quite out of keeping with this distinguished listed street where, on the corner of Gloucester Crescent and Regent's Park Terrace, it would be a conspicuous incongruity and eyesore.

2. Loss of daylight, sunlight in the garden of 70 Gloucester Cresc. Light and valuable sunlight, such scarce but essential commodities for London gardeners, would be lost. The whole character of the garden would change if the present garage is brought forward by a meter and a steep-angled roof built facing 70 Gloucester Crescent as proposed.

As it stands, I strongly object to this application.
