



Top left: third floor bathroom: hollow core 4 panel wood effect door (same as door to top stairs on third floor)

Top centre: second floor back bedroom: 4 panel pine door with run mouldings. Likely 1980's date.

Top right: second floor front bedroom: C19 door. Non original mortice lock, moulded panels do not fit with hierarchy/status of this floor of the house. Ie not original/or in original location. In modern frame.



Above left: first floor front room: poor modern door. Lock rail set too high. Original frame.



Above right: second half landing: modern hollow core door, ply faced to landing as 'jib' style door.



Above left: first half landing: ply faced and modern door to room off landing
Above right: ground floor, front room. Original looking but in fact softwood sections and mouldings applied to a ply back. Likely original style of door and used as basis for proposals.



Above left and right: the two basement bedroom doors, both of which are original, and will be retained.
