I would like to reject the planning application for an 'Extension at roof level to student accommodation (Class C2)' because of the following reasons.

1. The site already exists well outside of the original dimensions of the proposed development, which I as a resident already objected too, on the grounds that it is out of the character of the surrounding area, and offers no continuity in terms of design and general 'feel' of the area.
2. The height of the existing units already impedes on the general eye-line and subsequent feel as we look out of the rear of our own property and is an absolute eyesore, especially as the rear has not been finished, therefore the addition of extra units, would compound the unsightly and horrendous feel of the ongoing project.
3. The scheduled works have never been finished and as a result, the whole site looks like a shambles. Messy, unkept and in a state of disarray, nothing like the proposed finished design, which was originally submitted.
4. The whole idea that the block is solely for 'Student accommodation' is an absolute disgrace, especially as I personally have made enquiries into staying in the block and at no point in the initial meeting, was I asked if I was a student, or studying, therefore implying that the entry requirements, of being a student, are completely unfounded and make a mockery of the whole application in the first place,

On these grounds, I hugely object to more units or an extension at roof level to student accommodation.
