It is not clear without sight of detailed drawings and structural engineers' calculations that the proposed alterations to the size of door openings at ground and first floor levels do not run the risk of destabilizing the structure of this block of mansion flats of which Flat 2 is but one. Nor do we have any information as to the aesthetic impact on a good late Victorian building of unilateral alterations to one part of it. We therefore object to the application on the grounds that the aesthetic and structural outcomes are not known.

We further object to the proposal to install double glazed units to the windows of the ground and first floors of part of a Victorian building in a Conservation Area on the grounds that this would involve the replacement of the original window sashes matching others in the building with new ones that would have to be of more substantial dimensions in both frame and glazing bars to accommodate the double glazed units. The harmony and integrity of the front and rear elevations of the building would thereby be destroyed.
